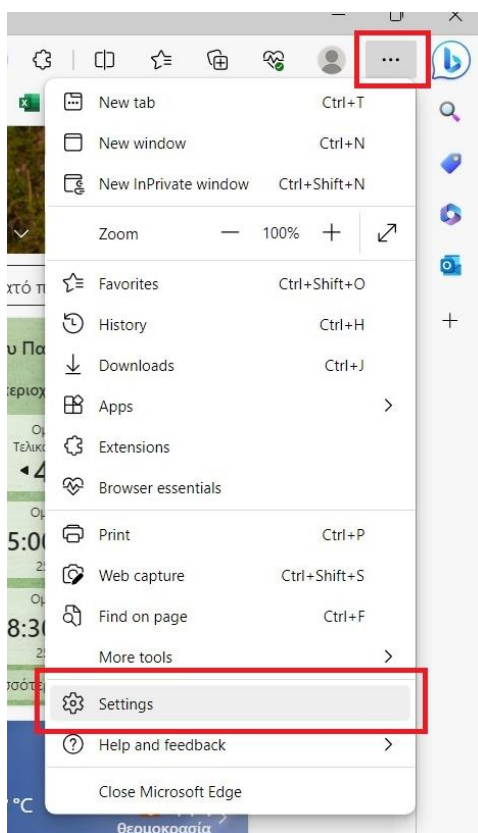

## 1. How to export your class1 certificate using Microsoft Edge

---

- Launch **Microsoft Edge** and choose ... → **Settings**.

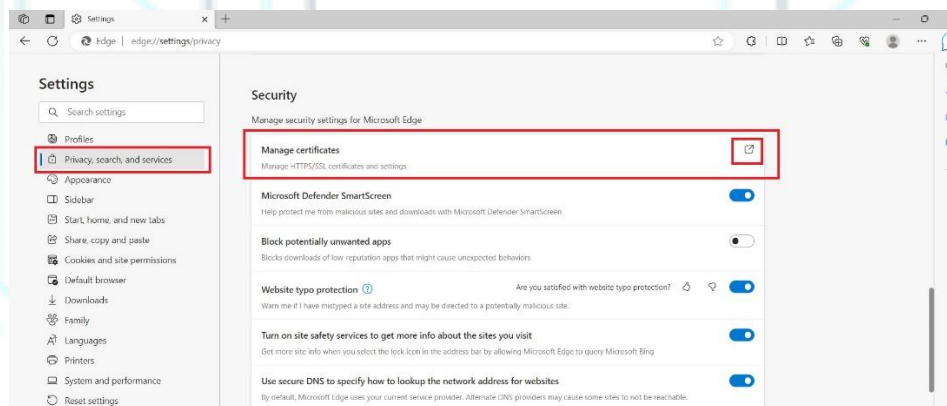


- Go to “**Privacy, search and services**” and choose “**Manage certificates.**”

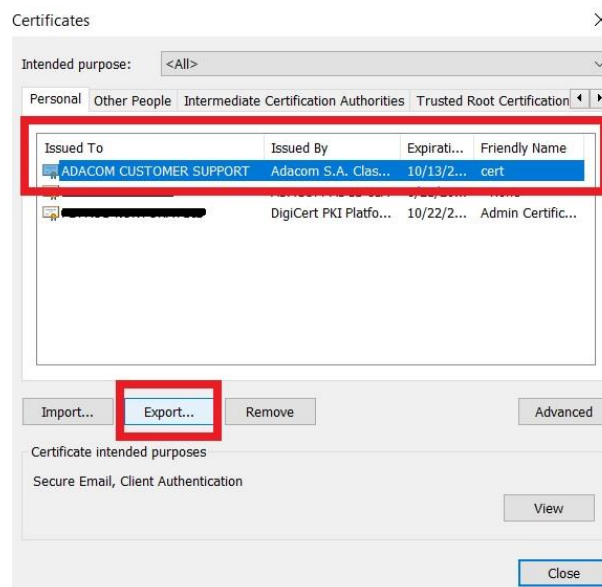

- Choose the certificate you want to export from the list and click on the **“Export”** button.

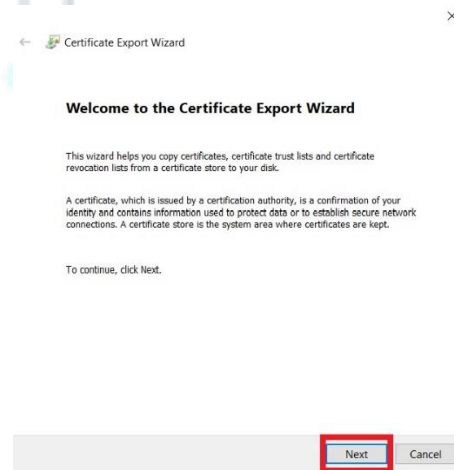


- Click **next**.

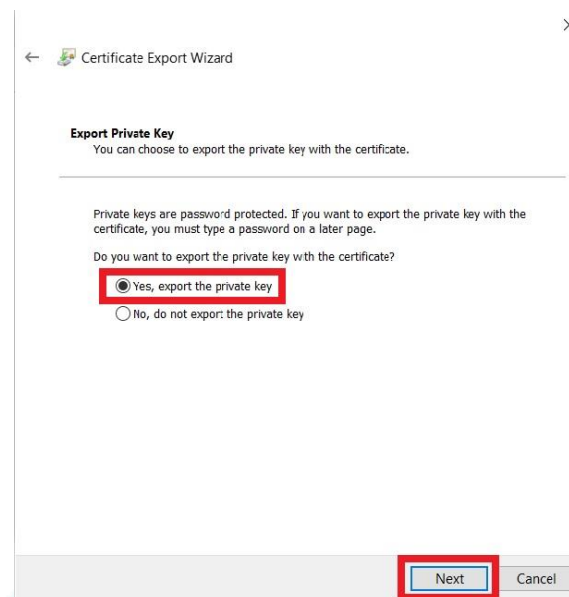

- Choose **“Yes, export the private key”** and click **next**.

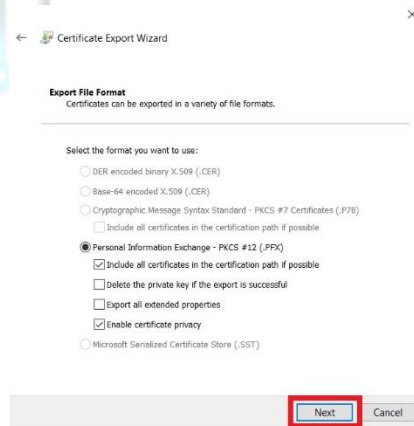

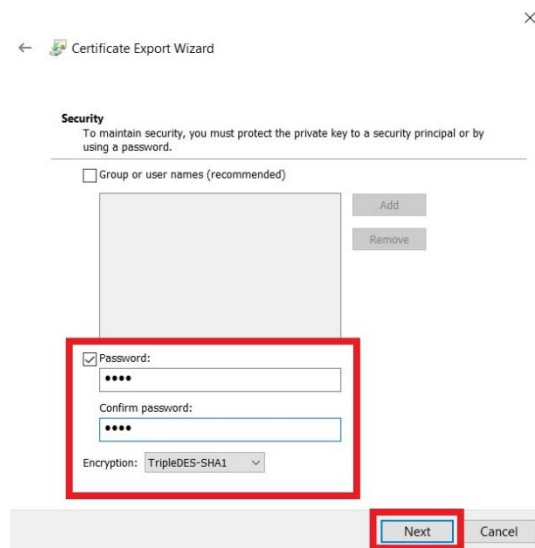

- Tick the **Password** option and fill in a **new password** that you will then use on the exported certificate file.



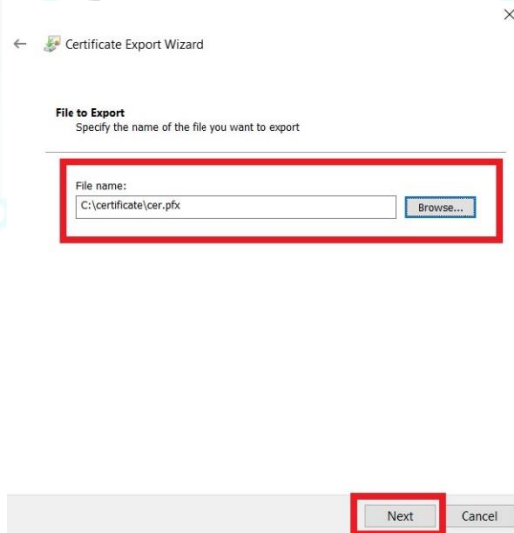
- Click on **“Browse”** and choose where to save the exported file on your computer then click **next**.

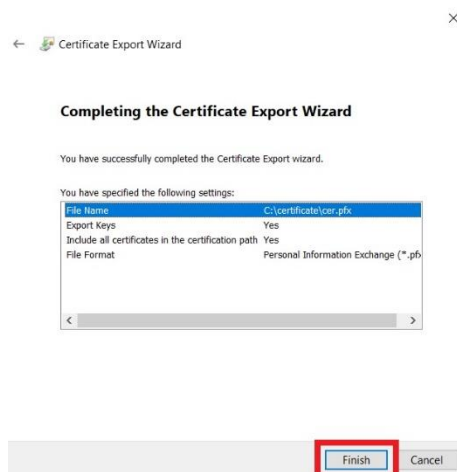

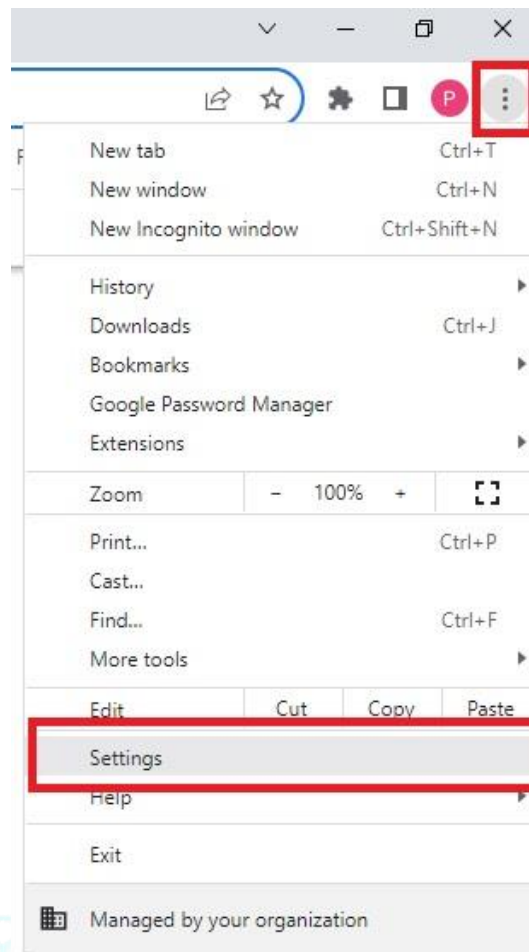

- Launch Google Chrome and choose  → **Settings**.

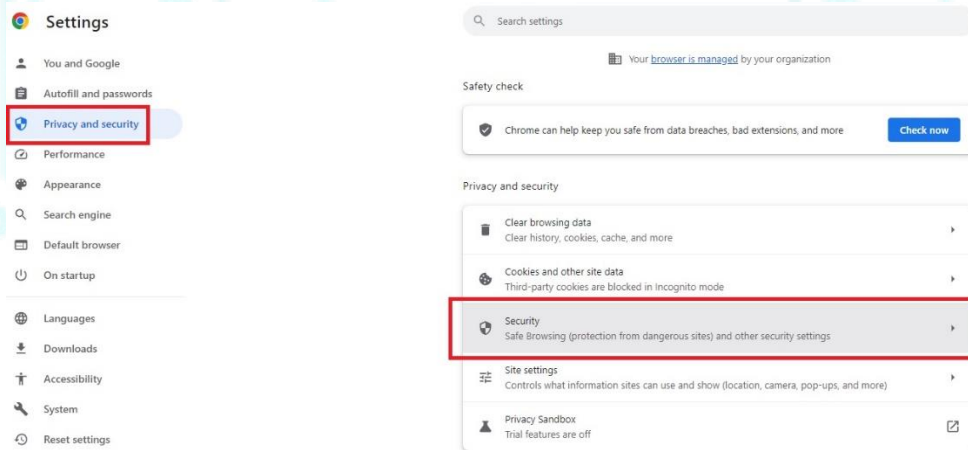

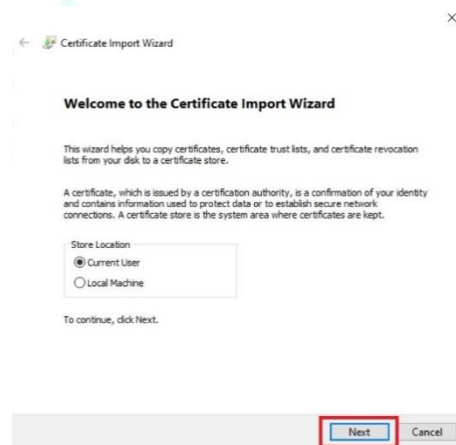
### 3. How to import your certificate on a new computer

---

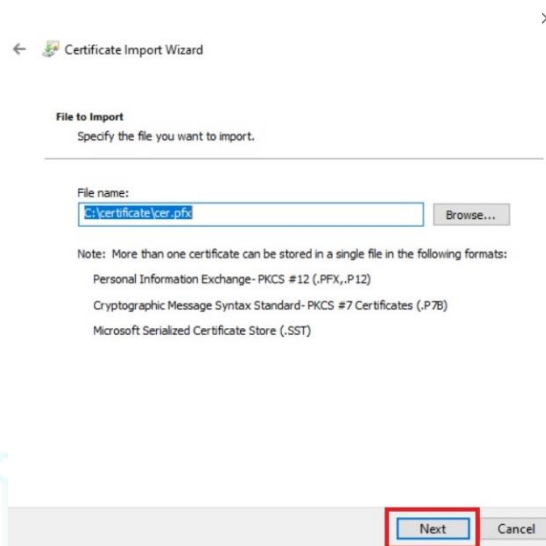
- Copy the certificate file to your new computer then right click on it and choose **Install PFX**

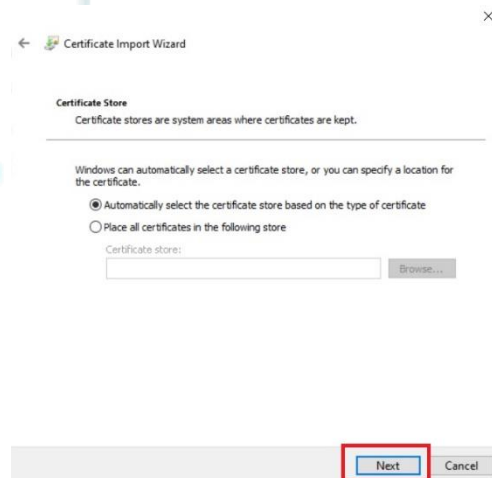

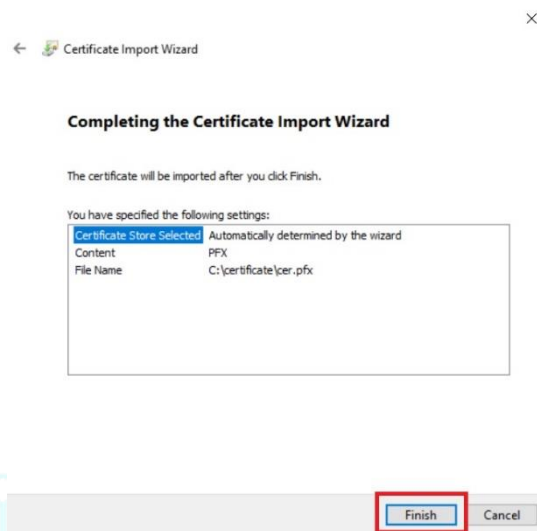
